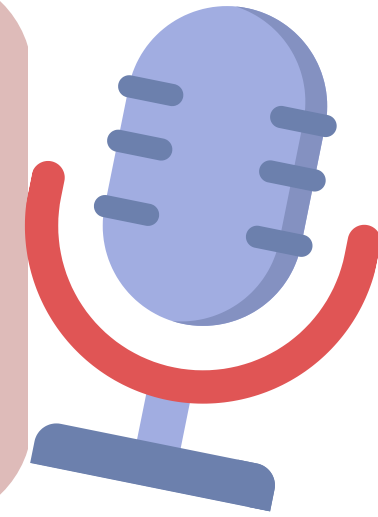


DEVELOPMENTAL LANGUAGE DISORDER

It's common. 2 in 30 children have DLD.

DLD often co-occurs with reading/writing challenges, like dyslexia.



DLD is often misidentified as poor behavior or inattention in class.

Speech-language pathologists evaluate, diagnose, and treat DLD.
